## Minutes of Constitution Revision Membership Meeting

Sunday, May 15, 2016

Lynda Shannon, Vice Chair, called the meeting to order at 12:30pm

Mary-Jane Cross, Clerk, confirmed a quota of 78 members were present.

L Shannon called for a motion to appoint a moderator / parliamentarian. W McEvoy / R Burnham moved to appoint Ted Fetter, past Metro District President, as moderator / parliamentarian – passed unanimously.

Revisions Proposed to Move/Discuss/Vote

- 1. L Shannon / R Burnham moved to accept the changes proposed for Article III Purpose (simplified, clarified). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- 2. L Shannon / L Hudson moved to accept the changes proposed for Article V Governance (updated for policy governance, Senior Minister made CEO). After a discussion about mandating the role of Chief Executive Officer for the Senior Minister, the motion passed with 2 opposed.
- 3. W McEvoy / R Burnham moved to accept the changes proposed for Article VI Membership (updated to current practice for monitoring membership roster). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- 4. W McEvoy / M Bishop moved to accept the changes proposed for Article VII Membership Meetings (updated to current practice for monitoring membership roster). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- 5. L Shannon / MJ Cross moved to accept the changes proposed for Article VIII Board of Trustees (updated for policy governance, limits of Board's powers spelled out, names of officers updated, list of standing committees removed, Audit Committee made a committee of the Board). After a few clarifying questions were asked and answered, the motion passed unanimously.
- 6. W McEvoy / M Bishop moved to delete current Article IX Officers (existing article deleted, duties of officers moved to policies). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- 7. W McEvoy / R Burnham moved to accept the changes proposed for Article IX (NEW) Elections and Vacancies (existing article deleted, duties of officers moved to policies). A clerical error was noted and fixed: the acronym NLDC was replaced by the full title "Nominating and Leadership Development Committee". The motion, as adjusted, passed unanimously without discussion.
- 8. S Mollica / T Hearne moved to accept the changes proposed for Article X Elected Committees of the Congregation (existing article deleted, duties of officers moved to policies). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- 9. S Mollica / MC Bue moved to accept the changes addition of Article XI Indemnification (NEW, recommended by attorney). After a discussion about the intent, meaning and appropriateness of the article, the motion passed with 1 opposed.
- 10 I Mason / C Onvemelukwe moved to accent the changes proposed for Article XII -

call or terminate a minister updated). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.

- 11. W McEvoy / MJ Cross moved to accept the changes proposed for Article XIV Amendments (time limit for ratifying amendments spelled out). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- 12. W McEvoy /S Mollica moved to accept the changes proposed for Article XVI Governance Policies (updated "Bylaws" to "Governance Policies"). The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
- 13. R Burnham / D Haffner moved to approve the Constitution as amended at this meeting. The motion passed unanimously without discussion.
